
Sub: Additional allocation of 41.111 tons of wheat and 17.619 tons of rice per month from April to June, 2017 (i.e. for 3 months) to Gujarat at MSP/MSP derived prices for drought relief-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. PDS/14-2017/891/C1 dated 22.05.2017 on the above mentioned subject. The request received from the Govt. of Gujarat for allotment of additional foodgrains for drought relief has been examined in this Department and it has been decided to allocate 41.111 tons of wheat at MSP rates and 17.619 tons of rice at MSP derived prices per month from April to June, 2017 to Gujarat to enable the State Govt. to meet its additional requirement for drought relief.

2. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the above additional allocation will be 30 days from the date of issue of this letter. The State Govt. is requested to ensure that the above additional allocation of foodgrains is lifted within the stipulated validity period and a Utilization Certificate for the additional allotment may also be furnished to this Department. The State Govt. is also informed to review the situation after 3 months and if further requirement of foodgrains arises, the State Govt. may send their request indicating the number of beneficiaries, scale of distribution and Utilization Certificate of this allocation accompanied by the recommendation of M/o Agriculture and Farmers Welfare as per the existing policy of the Government.
