Sub: Monthly allocation of foodgrains to Telangana for AAY, BPL and APL categories under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) from July, 2014 onwards till the implementation of NFSA - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.PDS.II(1)/TG/68/2014 dated 13.06.2014 on the above subject and to say that consequent upon enforcement of the AP State Reorganization Act, 2014 and formation of two separate States Andhra Pradesh and Telangana based on population ratio 58.32 : 41.68 respectively out of the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh State w.e.f. 02.06.2014 and as an interim measure, following monthly quantities of foodgrains have been allocated to Telangana State for AAY, BPL and APL families under TPDS from July, 2014 onwards till the implementation of NFSA:

2. The Validity period for lifting of these allocations will be fifty (50) days for each allocation month separately, starting from the first day of the month preceding the allocation month and ending on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the allocation month. It will be mandatory for State and UT Governments to deposit the cost of foodgrains to FCI latest by 15<sup>th</sup> of each allocation month (crediting the amount to the FCI account). However, lifting of foodgrains in instalments against allocations within the validity period will be allowed. Beyond 15<sup>th</sup> day of the allocation month, the Field Officers of FCI will not accept payment from the State/UT Governments for issue of foodgrains during the allocation month. Detailed instructions on deposit of cost and lifting of foodgrains under TPDS and extension of time/revalidation of TPDS foodgrains have been issued vide this Department's letter No.1-2/2007-BP-III dated 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2011. **However, the validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the allocation for the month of July will be 50 days from the date of issue of this letter.**

3. The rice allocated under TPDS should be distributed in the form of whole grains. However, the wheat allocated may be distributed as wheat flour/atta or fortified wheat flour/atta through the network of fair price shops to APL category of ration card holders under the TPDS, subject to the terms and conditions as laid down in this Department's letter No.4-7/2005-Py.IV/PD.I (Pt.) dated 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2008 as modified from time to time.

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4. The foodgrains allocated under TPDS should be utilized only for the purpose for which the same have been allocated and not for any other purpose/scheme. **This is in consonance with the Utilization Certificate which is required to be regularly furnished by your State/UT under the PDS Control Order, 2001 on mandatory basis.**
