**Sub: Revised allocation of foodgrains to Tripura from September, 2015 onwards on account of implementation of National Food Security Act (NFSA).**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter F. No. 5-2(5)-PP(PD)-DF/2009-10(V-III)/10176 dated 14.08.2015 on the above subject and to say that on account of implementation of NFSA in the State of Tripura and the request of the State Govt. for allocation of foodgrains accordingly, it has been decided to revise monthly allocation of foodgrains to Tripura from September, 2015 onwards. Accordingly, in partial modification of this Department's allocation letters No.1-1/2015-BP.III dated 23.02.2015 and 05.03.2015, the revised monthly allocation of foodgrains to Tripura under NFSA from September, 2015 onwards will be as under:

The above allocation under NFSA will supersede this Department's earlier normal TPDS allocation for AAY/BPL and APL categories issued vide letters No.1-1/2015-BP.III dated 23.02.2015 and 05.03.2015 and letters No.1-2/2015-BP.III dated 09.04.2015 and 10.04.2015 regarding additional APL and BPL allocation respectively made under TPDS upto 30.09.2015. Accordingly, above normal and additional allocation under existing TPDS will cease to exist w.e.f. 01.09.2015.

3. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of the above revised allocation for the month of September 2015 will be 30 days from the date of issue of this letter. The validity period for rest of the months will be as per the existing instructions conveyed vide this Department's letter No.1-2/2007-BP.III dated 11.07.2014. Further, any quantity of foodgrains already lifted in excess of the above revised allocation will be adjusted against the revised allocation of subsequent months.
