Dear Sir / Madam,

Please refer to the quarterly advisories being issued from time to time by this Department vide D.O. letters of even number including the last letter dated 09.12.2014 regarding lifting of the allocated foodgrains and various measures to be taken for strengthening and streamlining of TPDS.

2. This Department has allocated 50 lakh tons of rice for additional APL and BPL families on 7.7.2014 to those 25 States/UTs who had not implemented NFSA. However, as per the FCI's report, the lifting made by the States/UTs against the allocation upto January, 2015, is poor at around 48.5% in APL category. It is nil in case of Odisha, Uttarakhand and Puducherry and only 2.4% in case of Jharkhand. In case of Andhra Pradesh, Goa, Gujarat, Telangana and Daman and Diu, it is less than 50%. In case of Additional BPL, the lifting is only 70% upto January, 2015 allocation and it is nil in case of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Uttarakhand and Puducherry. In case of Goa, Telangana and Daman & Diu it is less than 50%. Thus it is a matter of concern that even after allotting the additional foodgrains at highly subsidized rates, the lifting is very poor. The state-wise lifting statement of additional APL and additional BPL is at **Annex I & II**.

3. In the case of normal TPDS allocation the lifting is comparatively better at around 85% upto January, 2015 allocation but it is less than 50% in case of Punjab, Telangana, Daman & Diu and Puducherry. In case of Punjab, NFSA is implemented but lifting is only 26%. The state-wise lifting statement of normal TPDS allocation is at **Annex III**.

4. Thus the States should ensure that the foodgrains allotted to them are lifted in full. It may also be mentioned that Government of India has enacted NFSA w.e.f. 5.7.2013. However, so far only 11 States/UTs i.e. Haryana, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, Punjab, Karnataka, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar and Chandigarh have implemented NFSA. All the States/UTs are therefore requested to complete the process of identification of beneficiaries under NFSA expeditiously and implement the Act with the extended time-limit of 4.4.2015.

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5. I would also like to draw your attention to the Conference of the Food Secretaries of States / UTs implementing NFSA held by this Department on 03.12.2014 and the Conference of the Food Secretaries of the States/UTs who are yet to start implementing the NFSA held on 10.12.2014. During the meeting on 03.12.2014, the status of implementation of NFSA was discussed and during the meeting held on 10.12.2014 the States/UTs were urged for early implementation of NFSA. During these meetings, various measures for strengthening of TPDS were emphasized which inter-alia includes correct identification of eligible households, door-step deliver of foodgrains, end-to-end computerisation of TPDS operations and setting up of effective grievance redressal mechanism. The recommendations of the conferences have already been forwarded to the States/UTs for necessary action. I look forward to due diligence from the States /UTs for timely implementation of all the requisite measures for ensuring the overall objective of food security in the country.
