Dear Sir/Madam,

Please refer to the quarterly advisories issued vide D.O. letters of no. 9/6/2010-PD-II/Vol.II including my last d.o. letter dated 30.09.2015 regarding lifting of the allocated foodgrains and various measures to be taken for strengthening and streamlining of Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS).

2. Government has enacted National Food Security Act (NFSA) which has come into effect on 05.07.2013 and the States/ UTs were required to implement the Act upto 04.07.2014. However, so far 25 States/UTs have implemented the National Food Security Act. The States are advised to implement the Act expeditiously.
3. This Department has been making allocation of foodgrains under existing TPDS/NFSA and also additional APL and BPL categories, which are at highly subsidized prices. The additional APL and BPL allocations have been made in the non NFSA States/UTs during current year upto the 31st March, 2016 or till implementation of NFSA by the States/UTs, whichever is earlier. However, it is a matter of concern that the lifting upto December, 2015 is not complete in respect of many States/UTs and it is very low in the case of some States/UTs. Under NFSA, the beneficiaries have a legal right to receive foodgrains in time. However, under NFSA it has been observed that the lifting upto December, 2015 is not satisfactory especially in the case of Jharkhand (69.5%) and Telangana (76.2%). In the case of Daman & Diu(14.9%) the lifting is extremely low. The State-wise lifting position upto December, 2015 is at **Annexure-I**.
4. Under the additional BPL allocation, the lifting upto December, 2015 is only 70.7%. It is low in the case of Arunachal Pradesh (62.3%), Uttar Pradesh (67.3%), D&N Haveli(52.5%) and very low in Jammu & Kashmir(31.7%), West Bengal(43%), and A&N Island(0%). Under the additional APL allocation, the lifting upto December, 2015 is only 74.9%. It is low in the case of Uttar Pradesh(74.7%). The State-wise lifting position of additional BPL and APL allocation are at **Annexure-II** and **Annexure-III**.
5. The States/UTs are advised to ensure complete and timely lifting of the foodgrains allocated by this Department, which are highly subsidized, so that the foodgrains reach the targeted beneficiaries in time.

6. I would also like to refer to this Department's letter dated 16.09.2015 and 3 reminder letters dated 05.10.2015, 28.10.2015 and 16.12.2015 (copy enclosed) wherein all States/UTs have been requested to furnish information on various aspects of implementation of TPDS in 17 proformas online. These letters have been sent vide email as well as by post to all States/UTs. I would like you to immediately furnish the online information for the period ending 31.03.2015(annually) as well as for the quarters ending 30.06.2015, 30.09.2015 and 31.12.2015 so that the information can be compiled centrally in this Department. The online information for subsequent quarters/annual periods afterwards may also be furnished on regular basis. A status report on online formats filled by each State/UT as on 15.11.2015 is enclosed at **Annexure-IV** and another updated status report on online formats filled will be intimated to you shortly.

7. Further, as per clause 8(3) of the TPDS (C) Order, 2015, the State Government shall ensure, through the authorised agency, physical delivery of foodgrains to the fair price shop (FPS) by end of the month preceding the allocation month and in any case not later than the first week of the allocation month.

8. In view of the above, States/UTs are advised to ensure door-step delivery of foodgrains to the FPS and to furnish door-step delivery information to this Department as per door-step delivery proforma. It is also to be noted that few States/UTs have appointed private contractors/transporters instead of authorized agencies for delivery of foodgrains to the FPS which is in violation of clause 8(3) of TPDS (C) Order, 2015. Therefore, States/UTs are advised to take corrective measures and to furnish updated status on door-step delivery to this Department at the earliest.

9. I shall be thankful if you look into the above issues and inform the action taken on the same at the earliest.
